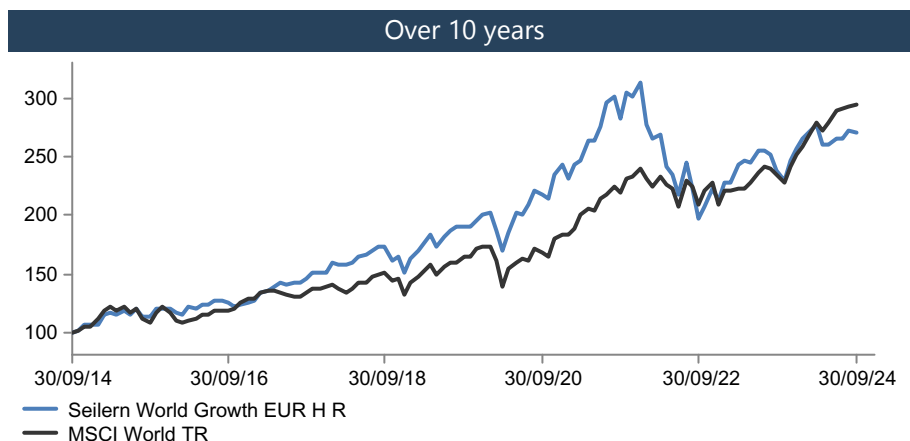
## Commentary

Straumann was the best performer, rising +10.20% after releasing better than expected second quarter results in August and announcing the sale of Dr Smile, its direct-to-consumer clear-aligner business. Nike was second best, up +6.10% on the news that the CEO was being replaced by Nike veteran Elliot Hill, whose experience spanned many senior positions in the company before his retirement in 2020. Novo Nordisk was the worst performer down -16.13%. The stock reacted negatively to the prospect of increasing competition in the obesity space and the potential for greater than anticipated pricing pressure as a result. Edenred was second worst, down -10.97%. The stock was weighed down by several macro headwinds: a French fiscal budget crisis, a slowdown in the French economy and consequent uncertainty regarding new meal vouchers regulation.

### Definitions:

The Seilern World Growth EUR H R fund is actively managed and uses the MSCI World TR as the benchmark index against which the Fund's performance is compared'. The MSCI World Index is a broad global equity benchmark that represents large and mid-cap equity performance across 23 developed markets countries. "TR" stands for total return, and it assumes any cash distributions, including dividends are reinvested. "CAGR" stands for the compound annual growth rate.

The **Ongoing Charges Figure (OCF)** is the total cost of running the Fund, including the cost of marketing, trading and distribution. The OCF is based on December month end of the prior year, and can vary year to year.
